CLOSING DATE FOR ENTRIES IS SEPTEMBER 3, 2011. APPLICATIONS AFTER THAT DATE WILL BE PLACED IN THE BACK OF THE PARADE AND ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR JUDGING.

1. NO THROWING OF CANDY OR ETC FROM ANY MOVING VEHICLE. Candy must be handed to the spectators or tossed onto the sidewalk by walkers.

2. LINE UP TIMES: 8:00 AM CHECK IN OPENS
9:00 AM SHARP JUDGING
9:45 AWARDS GIVEN OUT
10:00 PARADE BEGINS

3. All awards will be given out at the start of the parade or before the parade starts. Anyone NOT wishing to be judged may sign in between the hour of 9:00 and 9:30. Anyone that signs in after 9:00 am WILL NOT BE JUDGED. Please be ready at 9:45 for the parade.

4. You will receive your line up position from our check-in stand at the corner of Central Avenue and B Street SE, in front of B & B Glass. A parade person will direct you to the right street.

5: The parade will travel down Central Avenue, left on E Street to 2nd Avenue SE, left to C Street SE, right to 4th Avenue SE (Jr. High School), left to Division. Then you may disperse right to the festival grounds or left, back to the staging area. Walkers and children may stop at the Jr. High School to meet parents.

7: Quincy FCAD officials, Quincy Valley Lions, and designated law enforcement officers reserve the right to remove any unit not conforming to the above rules, or other laws pertaining to the safety of others.

There is lots of activity at the High School grounds and several farming tours are available throughout the day. Fresh produce is available for sale along with several crafts &

food booths.
